

Jump Securities with Auto-Callable Feature Based on the Performance of the S&P 500[®] Index due July 28, 2034 Fully and Unconditionally Guaranteed by Bank of America Corporation

Principal at Risk Securities

This document provides a summary of the terms of the securities. Investors must carefully review the accompanying preliminary pricing supplement referenced below, product supplement, prospectus supplement and prospectus, and the "Risk Considerations" on the following page, prior to making an investment decision.

The securities do not guarantee the repayment of principal and do not provide for the regular payment of interest. Investors will not participate in any appreciation in the underlying index. The securities are for investors who are willing to risk their principal and forego current income and participation in the appreciation of the underlying index in exchange for the possibility of receiving an early redemption payment or payment at maturity greater than the stated principal amount if the underlying index closes at or above the initial index value on an annual determination date, respectively. The securities are our senior debt securities. Any payments on the securities are fully and unconditionally guaranteed by Bank of America Corporation ("BAC"). The securities are issued as part of BofA Finance LLC's ("BofA Finance") "Medium-Term Notes, Series A" program.

Final index value:	The index closing value of the underlying index on the final determination date.
Index performance factor:	The final index value <i>divided by</i> the initial index value.
