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Summary Terms

The Notes:

- The Notes are designed for investors who seek quarterly interest payments on their investment and an additional payment at maturity if the closing level of the common stock of Monsanto Company (the "Underlying Stock") is at or above the Step Level (as defined in the attached offering document) on the valuation date shortly before the maturity date (the "Valuation Date"). Investors should be willing to lose some or all of their principal if the Underlying Stock declines by more than 10% (the "Threshold Level") on the Valuation Date. Investors should also be willing to accept that at maturity there will be no Step Payment if the closing level of the Underlying Stock is below the Step Level on the Valuation Date.
- The Notes will bear interest at a rate between 10% and 13% of the Original Public Offering Price per year per unit. Interest will be paid on the Notes quarterly in cash in arrears on November , 2008, February , 2009, May , 2009 and August , 2009.
- There is no principal protection on the Notes.
- The Notes are made available to each investor outside of the United States in a
 minimum initial investment of US\$50,000 (US\$100,000 for residents of the
 European Economic Area), and subject to any other restrictions, as may be
 applicable to an investor under the private offering rules of any jurisdiction
 outside of the United States.
- Merrill Lynch & Co., Inc. has applied to have the Notes listed on the American Stock Exchange under the trading symbol "MZJ". If approval of this application is granted, the Notes will be listed on the American Stock Exchange at the time of such approval. Merrill Lynch & Co., Inc. makes no representation, however, that the Notes will be listed, or, if listed, will remain listed for the entire term of the Notes (see "Other Provisions and Considerations" in the attached offering document).

- The Notes will be senior unsecured debt securities of Merrill Lynch & Co., Inc., and part of a series entitled "Medium-Term Notes, Series C" and will have the CUSIP No.:

Payment on the maturity date:

- In addition to interest that is payable, on the maturity date an investor will
 receive a payment (the "Redemption Amount") that will be based on the
 direction of and percentage change in the level of the Underlying Stock from
 the Starting Value of the Underlying Stock on the Pricing Date to the Ending
 Value of the Underlying Stock on the Valuation Date as specified in the
 attached offering document.
- If the Ending Value of the Underlying Stock is greater than or equal to 110% to 113% of the Starting Value (the "Step Level"), an investor will receive, per unit of the Notes, the \$10 Original Public Offering Price per unit plus 5% of the \$10 Original Public Offering Price per unit (the "Step Payment").
- If the Ending Value of the Underlying Stock is less than the Step Level, but greater than or equal to 90% of the Starting Value (the "Threshold Level"), an investor will receive the \$10 Original Public Offering Price per unit of the Notes.
- If the Ending Value of the Underlying Stock is less than the Threshold Level, an investor will lose a percentage of the principal amount based on the percentage decline in the level of the Underlying Stock in excess of the Threshold Level, from the Starting Value to the Ending Value.
